- I. **Purpose.** The Providence Water Supply is responsible for protecting the drinking water supply from contamination or pollution which could result from improper system construction or configuration on the retail connection owner's side of the meter. The purpose of this service agreement is to notify each customer of the restrictions which are in place to provide this protection. The public water system enforces these restrictions to ensure the public health and welfare. Each retail customer must sign this agreement before Providence Water Supply will begin service. In addition, when service to an existing retail connection has been suspended or terminated, the water system will not re-establish service unless it has a signed copy of this agreement.
- II. **Restrictions.** The following unacceptable practices are prohibited by State regulations.
 - A. No direct connection between the public drinking water supply and a potential source of contamination is permitted. Potential sources of contamination shall be isolated from the public water system by an air-gap or an appropriate backflow prevention device.
 - B. No cross-connection between the public water supply and a private water system is permitted. These potential threats to the public drinking water supply shall be eliminated at the service connection by the installation of an air-gap or a reduced pressure-zone backflow prevention device.
 - C. No connection which allows water to be returned to the public drinking water supply is permitted.
 - D. No pipe fitting which contains more that 8.0% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing on or after July 1, 1988 and prior to January 4, 2014 at any connection which provides water for human use.

- E. No pipe fitting which contains more that 0.25% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use on or after January 4, 2014.
- F. No solder or flux which contains more than 0.2% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing on or after July 1, 1988 and prior to January 4, 2014 at any connection which provides water for human use.
